Student Achievement Program Policy

The EHS board recognizes that the key work of school boards is to establish and promote a clear vision of student achievement as the top priority of EHS. Student achievement will be defined by EHS and include, but not be limited to, assessment results, student attendance and drop-out rates and diploma attainment.

The EHS Executive Director will ensure development and implementation of a comprehensive, collaborative planning process that engages the school community in the sponsoring district's continuous student achievement improvement program efforts.

EHS's program will be consistent with Oregon Department of Education requirements and reflected in the EHS annual report.

The EHS school board will, in striving for continuous improvement of student achievement, annually review EHS data on student achievement, prioritize, allocate and realign resources as necessary.

The EHS Executive Director will develop guidelines as needed to implement this policy.
