INSTRUCTION 600.13

Staff/Student/Parent Relations Policy

The Board encourages parents or guardians to be involved in their student's school educational activities and, unless otherwise ordered by the courts, an order of sole custody on the part of one parent or guardian shall not deprive the other parent or guardian of the following authority as it relates to:

1. Receiving and inspecting their student's education records and consulting with school staff concerning the student's welfare and education, to the same extent as provided the parent or guardian having sole custody; and
2. Authorizing emergency medical, dental, psychological, psychiatric or other health care for the student if the custodial parent or guardian is, for practical reasons, unavailable.

It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian with sole custody to provide any court order that limits the rights of the noncustodial parent or guardian at the time of enrollment or any other time a court order is issued.

In the case of joint custody, EHS will reasonably attempt to adhere to school related conditions specified and ordered by the court. EHS may request in writing any special provisions or clarifications in areas concerning the student and EHS's relationship and responsibilities.

EHS will use reasonable methods to identify and authenticate the identity of both parents or guardians.
